PIXLR Tutorial Video Outline

- 1. Why use PIXLR? PIXLR can be used in situations where you need a fairly robust photo editor but don't have the time or ability to install software like Photoshop or GIMP, for example at public computer, a work computer, or a friend or relative's computer. Since it's web-based, PIXLR requires no installation, administrator privileges, etc.
- Where is PIXLR? PIXLR can be found online at <u>www.pixlr.com</u>, specifically the PIXLR Editor web app.
- Demonstrate that PIXLR can open up local files, just like a program that has been locally installed.
- 4. Demonstrate the tools that are similar to those in GIMP/Photoshop et al: text, drawing tools, layers, colors, etc.
- 5. Demonstrate the image resizing function, and how it differs from other photo editors.
- 6. Demonstrate that PIXLR has its own internal menu interface separate from the browser's menu interface.
- 7. Demonstrate format and destination options for file saving (e.g. BMP vs. PNG, and saving locally vs. saving to an online PIXLR account).
- 8. Show the warning that occurs when you try to navigate away from your browser window or tab without saving your work first.
